COVID PRECAUTIONS

Thank you all for choosing to attend Star of the North 2020. To keep everyone as safe as possible we will be observing a few rules that are different from previous years in keeping with USBCHA and State of Minnesota guidelines. Your cooperation in observing these considerations will help keep you, your families, your communities safer so your compliance is greatly appreciated.

- 1) Masks – please have one and wear it in the port-a-potties at all times and any time that social distancing greater than 6 feet from non-family members cannot be observed. That means around the scoreboard or other areas where there are a number of people. Wear your mask whenever you can. It is the best form of protection against COVID-19
- 2) Please prop the port-a-potty doors open between use and when all possible allow a few minutes between you and the person ahead of you. The port-a-potties will be closer to the road so that we can have them serviced more easily. One will be closed Fri/Sat so that it is available for handlers only on Sunday.
- 3) There will be no Handler's Meetings. Please see attached for course instructions.
- 4) Concessions. Unfortunately we will not be able to provide the usual hospitality in the mornings or at lunch time Friday. There will still be coffee and hot water available but please bring your own mug if you would like some. We will take orders for lunch on Friday (we will pick up) and Sat (concessions on site) and will order in on Sunday.
- 5) Wash hands as often as possible please. There will be hand sanitizer available.
- 6) Spectators – Gale Woods is a public park and they will be having their own event on Saturday. They are restricting access compared to previous years but there will be members of the public with access to the trial field. We will be attempting to keep them out of the handler area and asking them to wear masks. If you have concerns, please bring them to me or to Gale Woods staff. Please do not direct your concerns to members of the public.
- 7) Please complete the attached Waiver of Liability and provide it to me before your first run.

These are the course instructions for the trial. If there are any changes required, we will either post them, or call an actual Handler's Meeting.

Open 1 (400 yard outrun, 400 yard drive)

Start at 7AM. If you would like to walk the course, please do it Thursday evening or before 7AM.

We will run four (4) sheep.

Time will be 10 minutes.

Left hand drive

Maltese Cross (see diagram)

Split – any two.

Nursery 1 and ProNovice 1 (250 yard outrun, 200 yard drive)

Nursery will start after Open and ProNovice will follow Nursery.

We will run four (4) sheep.

Time will be 7 minutes

Left hand drive

Maltese Cross (see Diagram)

Saturday

Nursery 2 and ProNovice 2

Start at 7AM

We will run three (3) sheep.

Time will be 7 minutes

Left hand drive

Maltese Cross (see Diagram)

Open 2

Start after ProNovice 2

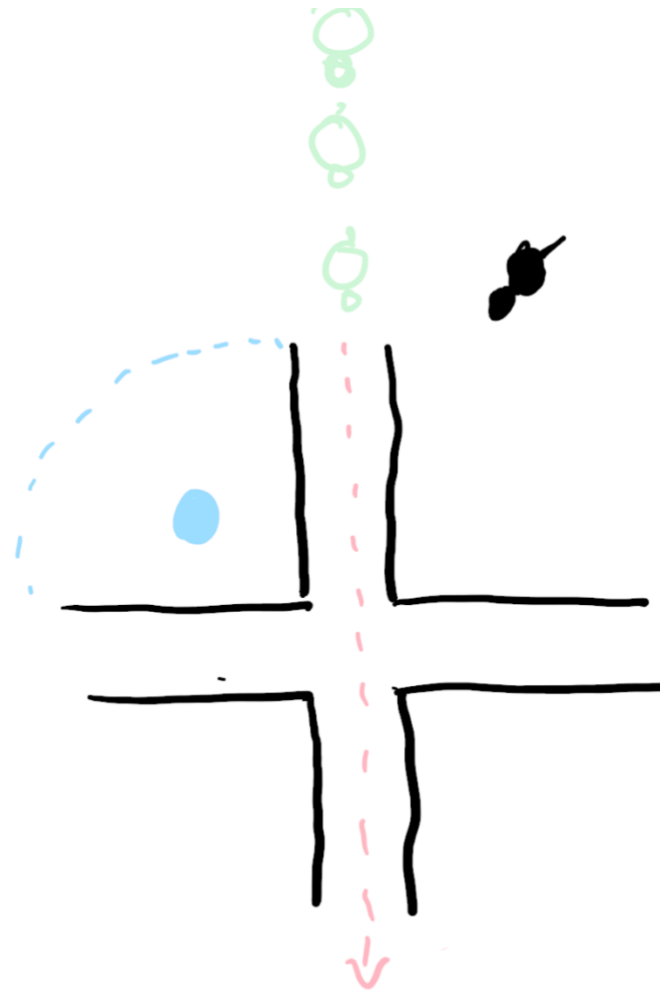

Maltese Cross



1. Handler (blue dot) stays in 1 quadrant same as pen you have six feet from the end of the panel to hold your side.
2. Dog (black dot) holds the other side.
3. Sheep go straight through the long axis, then on to the shed (Open)
4. Handler can't reach into the chute.
5. Scored like a pen. All sheep must enter the chute. Points off for sheep not going straight in, or sheep turning into the cross-arms.

Directions.

The Handler's Entrance is
7077-7179 CR-15 Mound (Minnetrista)
MN 55364
(Lat 44.9397, Long -93.7048).

From Mound MN, go West on CR-15 (Lynwood Blvd). The entrance is on the left, just past the sign for Voyageurs Resort. Please close the gate behind you.

The Main Park Entrance is
7210 County Road 110 W
Minnetrista, MN 55364
From Mound MN, go SW on Co Rd 110 W (Bartlett Blvd)

If you are pulling a big rig, use the Main Park Entrance. Keep right through the parking lot area and follow the gravel road to the right of the machine yard up to the trial field.

If you are arriving by car or pulling a smaller camper, use the Handler's entrance. You can either turn sharp left where the road forks and come up the hill to the north end of the trial field OR keep right and follow the road around through the valley below the trial field until you reach the main gravel road, then turn left up the hill to the trial field.

Day parking is east of the gravel road nearest the south end of the field. (shaded blue on the photo)

Camping is east of the gravel road past the hay bales or in the flat area north of the ProNovice setout (shaded yellow on the photo).

There is a running track on the west side of the gravel road between the road and the trial field. Please do not drive on the running track. Please do not park on the running track. Please keep your speed on the gravel road to 10mph.

If we need additional camping space, there is room in the hayfield in the valley for smaller campers (it would be difficult to get a large rig into).

There are restaurants and a grocery store in Mound and all are open with limited seating or take out.
